MATH

Saxon

SPELLING

Spelling and Poetry 3 gives students 34 spelling lists complete with vocabulary words with definitions and implementation exercises. Eight poems are also included in this textbook to help students appreciate the beauty of language and literary value of poetry.

GRAMMAR

Language 3 furthers students' knowledge of capitalization and punctuation as he/she improves sentence writing. Students are introduced to nouns, verbs, and adjectives while learning all 8 parts of speech.
